The above Tract is an Interference of a large tract of land called Carrollsburg (the lower tract) granted by Charles Carroll to William Cochran the 6th May 1757. Part A, by the running of the line in 1763 fell to the Penna side. Part B, is situated in Maryland, now owned by James and Henry Mc Divitt. Part A is situate in Liberty Town P. Adams County.
