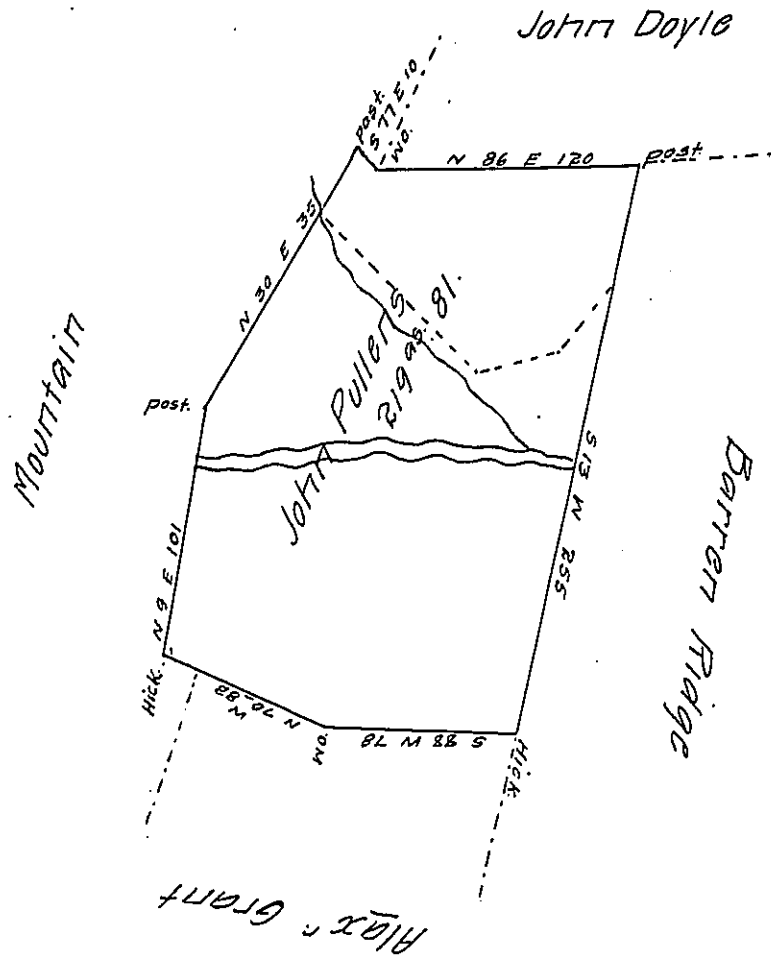


FORM NO 1.

the dotted lines represent part of the draught of a tract of land surveyed for John Masters on warrant dated the 17th day of September 1787 This tract interferes fifty one acres and one hundred and fifteen perches with the John Pullens survey.
