These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd in y^e remaining part of y^e township of Concord the afore mentioned number of acres, according to y^e method of townships by me appointed, & make return thereof into my Secretarys Office. Given at Chester y^e 6th of y^e 12th month, 1682.
