I hereby authorize thee to survey and lay out unto y^e their respective quantities of land in ye afore mentioned County in a place where not already taken up according to ye method of townships appointed by ye Govern^{or} and att^r all form^d warrants. And make me a true returne thereof which is to remain on record in my office Philadelphia this 9th of ye 4th moneth 1685.
