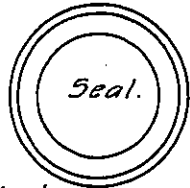


Pennsylvania ss.

At the request of Thomas Fairman that we would grant him to take up five hundred acres of land ~~and~~ in this Province further in right of his Purchase of five thousand acres ~~made~~ of Thomas Harley Esq Original Purchaser of the sd quantity from the Prop<sup>r</sup>. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd to the sd Thomas in the right aforesd and according to ye method of townships appointed the sd quantity of five hundred acres of land that has not been already survey'd nor ~~is~~ taken up nor is concealed nor seated by the Indians and make returns thereof into ye Secretaries office: Given under our hands and seal of the Province at Philad<sup>a</sup> the tenth day of September A D. 1708.
