

By the Commissioners Impowered to grant lots and lands in ye Province of Pennsylvania & the Territories thereunto belonging.

Whereas ye Governour upon his imbarquing for England granted a warrant to Ralph ffretwell & Comp^a for a Considerable tract of land to be layd out either in ye County of Chester or on Schookill according to ye tenor therein expressed, which said tract could not be wholly layd out in Chester County or on Schookill to content, without interfering with precedent warrants & settlements, Wee with ye Consent^(obl.) Concurrence of him ye said Ralph ffretwell & Comp^a in^(obl.) proprietaries & Governour's name, doe hereby will and^(obl.) quire thee to survey or cause to be surveyed unto ye said Ralph ffretwell a tract of six miles square in ye County of Chester beginning half a mile above ye north^(obl.) Corner of Concord, and running six miles thence ea^(obl.) east half northerly, and from thence at right A^(obl.) to make up ye said six miles square & he seating and improving ye same within twelve months from ye date of survey according to regulation, and make return thereof to ye Governour's Secretary office. Given at Philadelphia the 9th of ye 10th mo. 1684.


