Whereas Jeremiah Collet and John Gibbons Sen^r both of y^e County of Chester have for some time past severally laid claim to y^e p^rference of purchasing a certain p^lcell of land in y^e Manor of Rocklands joyning on y^e lands of Rob^t. Brown W^m Galley and John Mercy in Bethel township and y^e lands of y^e s^d J^r Gibbons and whereas the s^d Jer. Collet in pursuance of an award of certain arbitrators by them indifferently chosen doth resign and quitt claim all p^rference to y^e s^d land or any priviledge therein whereupon y^e s^d J^r Gibbons hath requested of a grant of two hundred acres of y^e s^d land agreeing to pay for y^e same sixty pounds at or before y^e Tenth day of y^e second month next and five years rent for y^e time past at one Shill Sterling p^r Ct and to be held under y^e same rent forever hereafter These are to authorize and require thee forthwith to survey and lay out to y^e s^d John Gibbons y^e s^d quantity of 200 acres of land situate as aforesaid or as near y^e same as may be and make returns into y^e Gen^l Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain & a copy thereof to be Deliv^d to thee certified by y^e Secretary Given under our hands and y^e seal of y^e Province at Philad^{ia} 23 12^m 1702.
