~~to~~ I here by authorize thee to survey and sett out to Allin Foster six hund-  
 red acres, one ye northeast sid<sup>e</sup> of Taokany creeke and (obl.) lay out to Rich-  
 ard Warrell four hundred ninty five acres and lett (obl.) be surveyed next  
 after my last warrant of yesterdays date w<sup>ch</sup> was for two hundred forty  
 five acres to Neemiah Mitchell and returne me a duplicate of ye field worke  
 and protracted figure dated 6<sup>th</sup> 8: 1682.
