


By virtue of a General warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing date the 23^d of the 12th month 1702. There was resurvey'd ~~the~~ a tract of land in Upper Dublin township in the County of Philadelphia belonging to Thomas Fairman & Maddox beginning at a stake at a corner of Samuel Finneys land and running thence south east one hundred sixty four perches to a stake at a corner of R. Medlys land from thence south west by the said Medlys land five hundred and ten perches to a stake at another corner of the said Medlys land thence north west one hundred and fifty eight perches to a black oak then by the line of the land of Samuel Finney north east five hundred & six perches to the Beginning containing five hundred and eleven acres. dat the Patent on ye 11 Jan^y 1705.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twelfth day of August 1909.
