By virtue of a warrant from ye Com^{rs} bearing date ye 5th of ye 5th month 1686 directed to me I hereby Certifie into ye Secretarys office that I have caused to be surveyed and laid out ye 18th of ye 6th month 1686 unto William Harriman ffive hundred acres of land in ye County of Chest^r being part of ffifteen hundred acres bought of Thomas Bowman. Beginning at a Corn^r post of Charles Pickering's land thence north east by ye same seven hundred and ten p^{ch}es thence north west by ye said Pickering's land two hundred seventy ffour perches thence north east by Samuel Buckleyes land two hundred twenty ffive p^{ch}es thence south east by a line of trees two hundred ninety ffour perches thence south west by William Lowethers land nine hundred thirty ffive perches thence north west by a line of trees twenty perches to ye place of beginning containing and laid out ffor ffive hundred acres of land and is accordingly entered and recorded in my office at Philadelphia ye 8th of ye 6th month 1686.
