These are to will & require three forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto her ye sd number of acres in ye aforementioned County & place, where not already taken up, according to ye method of townships appointed by me, he seating & improving ye same wthin one year after ye date of survey, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 19th of ye 5th mo. 1684.
