At ye request of Benjamin Furley Purchaser of five Thousand acres, yt we
would grant him to take up one thousand acres, thereof in ye County of Phila-
delphia. These are therefore in the Proprietary's name to will & require thee
forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd number of acres, in ye
aforesd County, where not already taken up, according to ye Method of town-
ships appointed by ye Govern^r the seating & improv'ing ye same, within six
moneths from ye date of survey, & make returns thereof into ye Govern^r's Secre-
tary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 19th 10th mo. 1684.
