At ye request of Enoch Flower, yt I would grant him to take up five hundred acres
of land of his Purchase, ^{in ye township of Southampton} in ye County of Philadelphia. These are to will & re-
quire three forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye s^d number of
acres in ye aforementioned County where not already taken up, according to
ye method of townships appointed by me, and make returns thereof into
my Secretarys office. Given at Philadelphia ye 20th October 1683.
