These are therefore in the Proprietarys name to will & require thee fforthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him the said number of acres in the aforebb<sup>d</sup> County where not already taken up, according to the Method of towneshipp appointed by the Govern<sup>r</sup> he seating and improveing the same within six months after the date of survey and make returne hereof to the Secretarys office Dated at Philadelphia the 28<sup>th</sup> of 4<sup>th</sup> month 1686.
