At y^e request of Thomas Garrett, y^t I would grant him to take up a neck of land supposed to be about forty acres, bounding upon a neck of Neaman's Creek, Francis Smith, Thomas Usher & William Cloud seated together on y^e said Creek in y^e County of Chester. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey^d unto him y^e said neck of lands, provided it be not already taken up, according to y^e method of townships appointed by me & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at New Castle y^e 14th of y^e 3^d mo 1684.
