Layd out for Henry Gibbons and Samuel Sellers and Israel Hobbs 200 acres of land lying on the south ~~side~~ west side of mill creek beginning at a small marked Red oke being the corner tree of William Smith and running a longe the s^d ~~creek~~ Smiths line of marked trees 320 perches to a marked Spanish oke standing near mill creek from thence a long ye s^d creek sid-and severall courses to a marked whitte oke standing by the s^d Creek from thence W. S. W by a line of marked trees 405 perches to a red oke from thence S. S. E. 190 perches to ye first mentioned small Red oke.
