Then laid out for William Hearne Smith 90 acres of land lying on the West side of the Scookill creek beginning at Peter Yoakams ~~where~~ rather most corner white oak neere the said creek and running nor-west by the 5^d Yoakams line of marked trees into the woods 232 perches to A marked Black oak standing by the westernmost line of William Smith and running east down the said Smiths line of marked trees 90 perches to A white oak neere A Branch from thence southeast to a marked red oak neere A branch by the Scookill creek and from thence one severall courses along by the said Scookill creek side to the first marked tree.
