Purchas: his Lott in ye City of Philadelphia. Containing in Breadth Sixty foot and in Length two hundred forty and Seven foot. Bounded northward wth a Vacant Lott. East ward with Back Lotts. Southward with Reece Radwats Lott. and to ye West ward with yethird street from ye river Schuylkill. And is According (obl.) Entred and Recorded in my office (obl.) Philadelphia this 18 of May 1685.
