These are to Authorize thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the said David a Lott in ye sd City where to be found vacant proportionable to the sd Purchase and make Returns there of into the Secretaries office. Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the Second Month A.D. 1713.
