

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hand and seal of the Proprietary and Governour to me directed bearing date the 18th day of the 3^d month 1700.

I do hereby certify that I have caused to be surveyed unto James Brook and four of his Brothers and Sisters in right of their Father John Brook, Purchaser in England a certain Tract of Land five hundred acres where of is scituate in the Township of Limerick and the Remaining part thereof in a Township adjoyning both in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a post set in the ground being a corner dividing it from Richard Haines's land within the said Township of Limerick. from thence South West by a Line of marked trees five hundred perches to a post set in the ground from thence North West by a Line of marked trees two hundred and forty perches to a Hickery marked from thence North East by a Line of marked trees five hundred perches to another Hickery marked from thence South East by a Line of marked trees two hundred and forty perches to the place of beginning containing and laid out for seven hundred and fifty acres of Land. Surveyed the 9th day of the 9th month 1700 and Returned according to the above said survey and bounds into the Proprietary's and Governour's Secretary's Office the 30th of the 9th month 1700.
