These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd number of acres in ye aforemention'd County & Township provided it be not already taken up & make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 29th of ye 1st mo. 1684.
