

By Virtue of two Warrants from the Commissioners of Property Dated the 16th & 17th days of the 11th Month 1717 Each of them for Five hundred acres of Land to be laid out to John Budd and Sarah Morrey in part of three thousand— by them bought of Randal Janney being the Original ~~Resurvey~~ purchase of John Wilmer.— Surveyd and Laid out to the Said John Budd and Sarah Morrey One thousand acres in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a Post at a Corner of Samuel Marmion's Land and at a Corner of James Dickinson's Land. Thence Extending North West by the Land of Francis Daniel Pastorius ^{520.} ~~four hundred and sixty~~ pches to a second post. Then North ³²⁶ ~~three hundred and fifty~~ pches East by a line of Marked trees ~~three hundred and fifty~~ pches to a Third Post. Then South East by a Line of Marked trees ~~four~~ ⁵²⁰ ~~hundred and sixty~~ ^{pches} to a fourth post. then by the ^{sd.} ~~Land~~ Samuel Marmion's ³²⁶ ~~three hundred and fifty~~ pches to the Place of Beginning Containing One Thousand and Six acres. Returned into the Secretary's Office March the first Anno Domini 1717.
