



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners bearing Date the Twenty Eighth Day of August Annoq Domini 1719. Surveyed and laid out for John Budd and Humphrey Morrey A Certain Tract of land Scituate on a branch of Perqueamie - In the County of Philad<sup>a</sup> begining at a Black oak being a Corner of Samuell Marmions land. Thence N. West along the County of Bucks line Six hundred and Ten perches to a White oak Saplin - in ye 5<sup>d</sup> line. Thence by Vact land S. West one hundred and Thirty perches to a white oak Tree. Thence by Vact land S. East Ninety perches to a stake being a Corner of 5<sup>d</sup> Jn° Budds land. Thence by ye same S. East five hundred and Twenty perches to a stake. Thence by Samuell Marmions land N. East one hundred & Thirty perches to the place of begining. Containng four hundred Sixty and Seven Acres with Allowance of Six # Cent.
