



By Virtue of A Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the Day of — Surveyed and Laid out for John Budd and Humphrey Morrey A Certain Tract of Land Situate on A branch of Perkiomink Creek in the County of Philad^a Beginning at a White oak being a Corner of the Society Land. Thence by Land Reputed Henry Pennabaker's. South West one hundred and Eighty Perches to a Large B. oak. Thence by the S^d Land. North West Seventy and Two perches to a w^t oak being a Corner of other Land of the S^d John and Humphrey. Thence by the Same South West Two hundred Perc^s to a Post. Thence by Vac^t Land South East. One hundred Twenty Two perches to a Small hickery Marked for a Corner. Thence ^{by Vac^t—} North East one hundred and forty perches to a Post. Thence by Vac^t Land Two hundred and fourteen perches to a hickery Tree thence — Vac^t Land North East Two hundred and forty Perches to the Society Land. thence by the same North West Two hundred Sixty & four — to the place of beginning. Containing five hundred Acres wth Allowance of Six & Cent. Surveyed March ye 3^d 17²⁰/₂₁.
