 ing beineing at a post Set in the ground being a Corner deviding
 it from Richard Haines Land within the said Limbrick Township
 from thene South West by a Line of marked trees five hundred per-
 ches to a post Set in the ground. from thene North West by a Line of
 marked trees two hundred and fourty perches to a Hickry marked
 from thene North East by a Line of marked trees five hundred per-
 ches to another hickry marked from thene South East by a Line
 of marked trees two hundred and fourty perches to the first place
 of beineing. Containeing and Laid out for Seven hundred and fifty
 acres of Land. Surveyd the 9th 9th mo Ensuieing.
