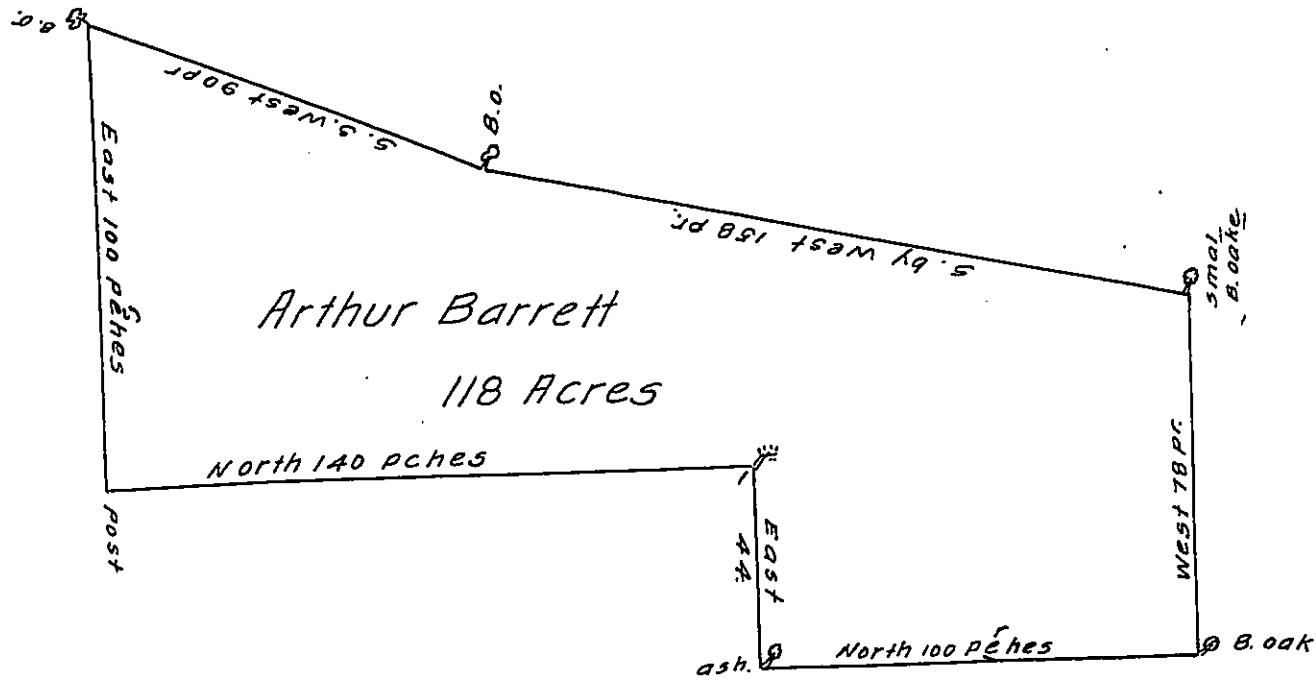


FORM No. 1.



By Virtue of a Warrant from ye Prop^rs Comm^rs Dated the 5th of ye 9th mo. North 1714. I survey'd to Arthur Barrett a Certain Tract of Land of Nottingham in ye County of Chester. Beginning at an Ash being a Corner of other Land of ye s^d Arthur Barrett. thence North by a line of Marked Trees one Hundred perches to a Black Oak. thence West Seventy Eight perches to a small black oak. thence South by West one Hundred fifty Eight perches to a Black Oak. thence South South West Ninety perches to a Black oak. thence East one Hundred perches to a post. thence North by other land of ye said Arthur Barrett one hundred & forty perches to a Maple. thence East by ye same Land forty four perches to ye place of Beginning containing one Hundred & twelve acres with the allowance of Six P. Cent.

Survey'd & Lay'd out by ye Surv^r Gen^l Ord^r ye 17th day of April 1716.

The Warr^t afore s^d was for 300^a and in pursuance thereof 300^a & Allowance was laid out to him on the 17th of April 1716 in another place & the s^d Arthur without paying any part of the Consid^r:- money sold to one Thrift of New England who neglecting to pay, the prop^r granted ~~the s^d 300^a~~ ^{part of ye s^d 300^as} ~~200^a~~ ^{200^a} to Joseph Hains of Nottingham in the year 1738 the s^d Barret having sold 100^as part to one porter.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty fifth day of May 1909.
