These are to will & require thee forth w<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto her a Lott in ye front of Delaware answerable to her Purchase, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 28<sup>th</sup> 17<sup>th</sup> 1683.*
