By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of William Bradford Jun^r of the City of New York
that We would Grant him to take up one Hundred and Twenty^{five} Acres
of Land in Right of Ralph Kinsey first Purch^{er} of the Same from
the Propriet^r by Deeds of Lease & Release dated ye 28th & 29th days
of October in the Year 1681 whose Eldest Son & Heir John Kinsey of
London by Like Deeds bearing Date the 11th & 12th days of February Anno.
1714 Granted the 5^d 125 Acres of Land unto the Said William Brad-
ford. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to
be Survey'd unto the Said William Bradford according to the Method
of Townships appointed the Said quantity of one hundred &
Twenty five Acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd
nor appropriated nor is seated by the Indians and make a Re-
turn thereof into the Secretarys Office in Order to a further
Confirmation. Given under our hands & Seal of the Province at
Philadelphia the 31st day of ye 8th month Anno Din. 1715.
