These are to Authorize thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the said Richard Buffington according to the Method of Townships appointed by the Propriet^{rs} the said quantity of five hundred Acres of Land in this Province that has not been already Survey'd nor taken up nor is concealed nor seated by the Indians. And make Returns thereof in the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands and Seal of the sd Province at Philad^{ia} the 26th day of the second Month 1707.
