

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commiss^{rs} of Property bearing date ye 29th of 10^{br} 1701 for Surveying unto Samuel Bulkly of Philadelphia fifteen Acres of Land in the Liberties of the City Philadelphia. ten Acres there of in right and as part of his and his Brother Thomas. Their first purchase of five hundred Acres of Land and the other five Acres in right of two hundred and fifty Acres purchased of Richard Davies of Denbigh Purchaser of the said Quantity under John up John and Thomas Wynne Original Purchaser of five hundred Acres which last five Acres were sold by Griffith Owen Attorn^y for the said Richard to Samuel Bulkly. Surveyd the 24th of the first month 1703 unto ann Bulkly. Relict of the said Samuel Bulkly now deceased the said Quantity of Land in the Liberties of the City Philadelphia. Beginning at a Corner post and running by the Line of John Thomas his Land West Seventy perches to a post. then by the line of John Balls Land North thirty four perches and a quarter to a post. Then East by Vacant Land Seventy perches to a post. Then by the Land of William Warner South thirty four perches and a Quarter to the place of beginning.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this sixteenth day of August 1909.
