


Pennsylvania.

By vertue of a warrant from ye Proprietary and Govern^r Bearing date ye 2th of ye 5th m^o 1683 directed to me I here by Certifie into his Secretaries Office that I have Caused to be Surveyed and laid out ye 29th of ye 5th m^o 1684 unto W^m Browne, Purchaser of one Thousand acres of Land his Proportion thereof in ye Liberties of ye City of Philadelphia. Begining at a Corn^r oak Saplin standing on ye Northermost side of a Small runn which runneth into the Mill Creek, thence West by a line of trees nin-ty p^{ches} to a Corn^r post. thence North by a line of trees Thirty Five p^{ches} & a halfe ~~thence~~ to a Corn^r Spanish oak standing on ye East Side of ye afore mentioned Mill Creek. thence East by Barnabas Wilcox Land nin-ty p^{ches}. thence South by a line of trees Thirty Five perches and a halfe to ye place of begining. Containing and Laid out for Twenty acres of Land. And is accordingly Entred and Recorded in my office at Philadelphia ye Thirty first of ye Eight M^o 1684.
