Doe hereby declare the Eighty acres omitted in the ~~Location of~~ ^{& to be allowed in & out of} Returne of Humphrey Soutes purchase of 1000 acres is layd out in their respective Lands of Thomas Barber, Samuel Jobson, Sabian Cole, John Mare & Joseph Moore in ye County of Chester. And so prevent any future scruples that may happen to arise concerning ye premises. wee ~~and~~ desire ye Surveyr Gen^l to Enter ~~the~~ & Record this in his Office. that there it may appear. how. where & in what maner both of ye sd psons. are satisfied. their respective purchased Lands afore sd.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set o^r hands. this Eight Day of ye first month. 1687. being ye ~~the~~ third year of ye Kings Raign & Seventh year of ye proprietary Government.
