By Vertue of a war.^t from ye Proprietary and Govern.^r dated ye 29th of 10^b. 1683. directed to me there by Certifie into ye Secretaryes office that there was Surveyed and Laid out ye 17th of ye 11th M^o 1683. unto William Byers (Rent^r) two hundred acres of Land in ye County of Chester and Township of Concord. Begining at a Corner ~~tree~~^{hickory} tree of William Hiscocks Land thence E.N.E. by ye same 480 p^rches. thence S.S.E. by a Street or Road Sixty seven p^rches. thence W.S.W. by John Mendinhalls Land 480 perches. thence N.N.W. by a line of trees 67 p^rches to ye place of begining which is accordingly Entred and Re-corded in my office at Philadelphia ye 15th of 10^b. 1693.
