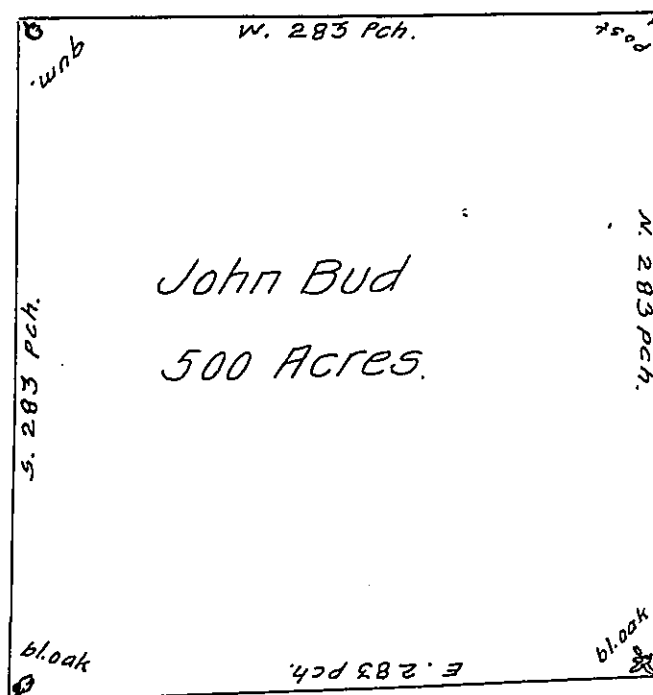

By Virtue of A Warrant to me directed dated the 12th day of ye 12th month 1709. I have surveyed and Layed out unto John Bud Atract of Land on the west side of Brandywine Creek beginning at A bounded black oak standing in A Line of John Simcocks Land thenc south 283 pch. to A bounded Gum in a Line of Tho. Fairman and Company Land. then west 283 pch. to A post standing on the N.W. side of A bounded Chesnut thenc - North 283 pch. to a bounded black oak standing in a Line of the sd Simcocks Land thenc - East 283 pch. to the place of beginning surveyed ^{for} and Containing 500 acres of Land the 24th ¹²/_{th} 1701.
