At ye Request of Thomas Bowman, Purchaser of five Thousand
Acres. y^t I would grant him to take up his Lotts in ye City proportio-
nable. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause
to be survey'd unto him ye Lotts both in front & high Street where
they fell, he fencing y^m in & building upon ye front according to
Regulation, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office.
Given at Philadelphia ye 19th of ye 4th mo. 1683.
