to him Tenn Acres w.<sup>th</sup> in ye Bounds there of according to ye method  
of Townships appointed by me. & make returns thereof into my  
Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 4<sup>th</sup> of ye 5<sup>th</sup> mo 1683.
