By Vertue of a Warr from ye Proprietary and Govern^r Bearing Date ye 21st of ye 3^d mo 1683 directed to me. I here by Certifie in to his Secretaryes Office yt I have Caused to be Surveyed and set out ye 29th of ye 3^d mo 1683 unto unto David Brintnall in Right of Edmond Lovett Purchaser his Lott in ye City of Philadelphia. Scituated Between ye 3^d and 4th Street from Delaw^r. Containing in Breadth fourty nine foot and a halfe and in Length two hundred fifty five foot. Bounded northward wth Chesnut Street, Eastward wth David Brintnalls Lott. South ward wth back Lotts. West ward wth a Vacant Lott. And is Accordingly Entred and Recorded in my Office. Philadelphia this 5th of ye 6th mo. 1684.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this ninth day of September 1909.
