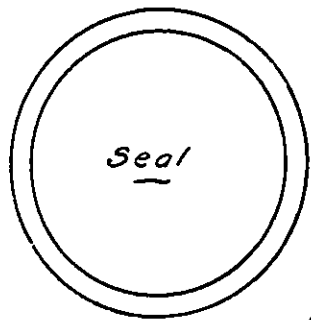

At the Request of Jn^o Parsons That I would grant him a Resurvey
on a certain Tract of Land Scituate in the County of Bucks near the ffalls
of Delaware, laid out to him for two hundred and fifty Acres. These are to
require thee forthwith to re survey or cause to be re surveyed unto him the
said Tract according to its first bounds and Lines of Survey. And make
Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given under my hand and seal
at Philad^{ia} the 4th of y^e first Moth 170²
