By ye Commission<sup>rs</sup> impower'd to grant Lotts & Lands in ye Provi<sup>(obitu)</sup>  
of Pennsylvania, & ye Territories thereunto belonging

At ye Request of Henry Paxton in right of Samuel Allen Purchaser  
of Two Thousand Acres, for ye use of ye Heirs of Charles Plumley y<sup>t</sup> we  
would grant him to take up one hundred Acres of Land in ye County of  
Bucks. These are in ye Proprietary's & Govern<sup>rs</sup> Name to will & require  
thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye s<sup>d</sup> number of  
acres in ye aforementioned County where not already taken up, he seat-  
ing & improving ye same w<sup>th</sup> in six Months from ye Date of Survey accord-  
ing to Regulation, & make returns thereof into ye Secretarys Office.
