



By virtue of a Warr^t. from the Commission^{rs} of Property bearing date the 17th of 9^{ber} 1715 Surveyed & laid out unto Edward Roberts a tract of Land in the great Swamp in Bucks County, Beginning at a Spanish oak in Joseph Jones's Line, from thence extending West by Vacant Land 200 perches to a White oak, Then North by Vacant Land 200 perches to a Hickory tree, Then by John Edwards's Land East 200 perches to a Post by a white oak, Then by the 5^d Joseph Jones's Line South 200 perches to the beginning Containing two hundred & fifty acres; Laid out by order of the Surv^r. Gen^l the 30th of the 1st month 1716
