



By virtue of a Warrant from Richard Hill Isaac Norris and James Logan to me directed bearing date the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the Sixth Month 1726 I have caused to be Surveyd on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of June 1727 unto Peter Rich of Upton in the County of Oxon in Great Britain a Piece of land in the Great Swamp in the County of Bucks containing two hundred and forty six acres in the City Liberties being the Original Purchase of Jeremiah Waring of the City of London the said Tract or Piece of land beginn<sup>d</sup> at a white oak at a corner of John Lester's land Then by the same South two hundred and forty perches to a post. Then by a line of marked trees West One hundred and sixty perches to a small white Oak Then by Joseph Growdon's land North two hundred and sixty perches to a white oak Then East by a line of marked trees One hundred and sixty perches to a small white oak Then South twenty perches to the place of beginning Containing two hundred and forty six acres with Allowance of Six PCent
