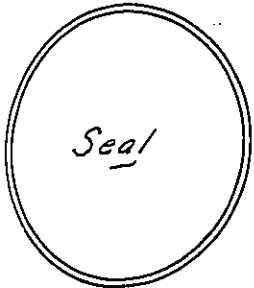

Whereas Thomas Revel of Burlington appointed Trustee & Executor for Managing Selling and ~~Conveying~~ ^{Esqr} Disposing of the Estate late of Jn^o Grey als Tatham of Burlington ~~Esqr~~ hath sold & convey'd to William Stevenson of West Jersey & Thomas Stevenson his brother now of this Province a certain Tract of Land reputed to contain two thousand five hundred acres, being part of three thousand Acres as is affirmed laid out to the 5^d Jn^o Tatham on the forks of Neshaminy ~~estate~~ In right and part of his purchase of 5000 Acres made of the Proprietary out of W^{ch} 5^d Tract of 3000 Acres he the 5^d J Tatham is said to have granted away 500 Acres in his life time These therefore are at y^e Request of the said William & Thomas Stevensons to Authorize & Require thee to Resurvey exactly & according to the true & Original Lines of Survey & Division the 5^d Tract of two thousand five hundred Acres of Land Scituate as afores^d & make Returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delv'd ^{Copy Sent} to thee certified by y^e Secretary. Given under our hands & y^e Seal of y^e Province at Philad^{ia} 14th X^{bris} 1702.
