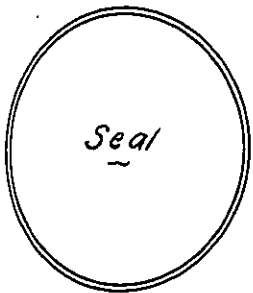

*At the Request of John Stackhouse That I would grant him
a Resurvey on a certain tract of Land in Middletown in the County
of Bucks on which he is seated cutt off for 200 Acres out of a Tract
laid out for 250 Acres on Meshaminet Creek to Nicholas Waln Purchaser.
These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey or cause to be resurveyed
the 5^d Tract as now cutt off according to the first out lines of the first
Tract and the Division Line since run therein also to try the quantity
of the remainder and make Returns into my Secretaries Office.
Given under my Hand and Seal at Philad^{ia} the 22^d of the first
month 170²*
