 hundred thereof in ye County of Bucks. These are therefore in ye Proprietary's
 name to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto
 him ye 5^d number of acres in ye afores^d County, where not already taken
 up according to ye method of Townships appointed by ye Govern^r: he seating
 & improveing ye same wthin six months from ye date of survey & make returns
 thereof into ye Govern^r: Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 20th ^{10^m}/₁₇₇₀
 1684.
