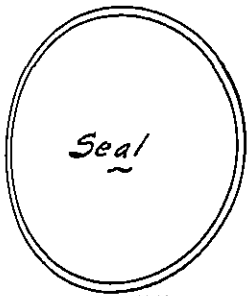


Pennsylvania ss.

By the Commission^{rs} of PropertyAt the Request of Elizabeth Sands Relict of Will^m Norcross

That we would grant her to take up five hundred Acres of Land in this Province in right of Leonard fell Original Purchaser of the said quantity granted by the said Leonard in his Lifetime to the said William and by him in his last Will and Testam^t devised to his said widow ^{& his children} John William, Sarah and Thomas Norcross: These are to authorize and require thee to survey and lay out to the said Elizabeth for the uses in the said last will mentioned, the said quantity of five hundred acres (according to the Method of Townships) of Land that has not been Surveyed nor taken up nor is concealed nor seated by the Indians; And make Returns into y^e General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a copy thereof to be del^{vd} to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 11th of 8^{or} 1703
