



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Comm^{rs} to me directed bearing date the 19th day of the 3^d month 1702 Resurveyed unto John Scarborough a Tract of Land in Soulbury Township in the County of Bucks, Beginning at a heap of stones by a small white oak, Thence by vacant and Thomas Bye's land N.W. 252 perches to a Post. Then by Incognita N.E. 324 perches to a black oak, Then by Incognita and great Spring Tract^{S.E.} 252 perches to a Post by a white oak, Then by Thomas Bye's Land S.W. 324 perches to the place of beginning Containeing 504 Acres, Resurveyed the 12th day of the 8th month 1702.
