



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Comm^{rs} to me directed bearing date 30th day of the 9th month 1702 to lay out unto Joseph Pike 1000 acres of Land in the County of Bucks in right of his purchase of 5000 acres under Samuel Rolls - original purchaser of the said quantity; Surveyed and laid out unto the s^d Joseph Pike a tract of land in Soulberry township in the s^d ~~Co~~ County beginning a Post 2 pole S.E. from a corner marked Maple being Randal Blackshaw's Corner, Thence N.W. by s^d Blackshaw's line 188 perches to a black oak Sapling 17 perches over Paunacussink Creek, Then by vacant land 320 perches to a Post, Then by vacant land S.E. 188 P. to a Post at George Brown's corner, Then by s^d Brown's line S.W. 320 perches to the place of beginning Containing 376 acres laid the 5th day of the 3^d month 1705
