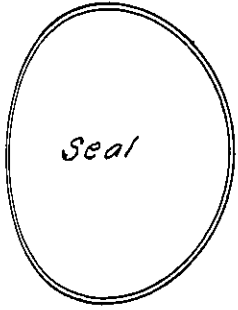

At the Request of William Smith of Wrights Town in the County of Bucks that we would grant him a Resurvey on a hundred acres of Land joyning to his other Land in ye same Township and also that he might hold the same in Right of John Rowlands original Purchase of whom he purchased that quantity and hath for about twenty years claimed it in the said Right and now agrees to pay to the Prop^{rs} use for a confirmation thereof five Pounds Money of Pensilv^a and the arrearage of quitrent due thereon. These are to Authorize & Require thee to Resurvey or cause to be Resurveyed unto the said William Smith the said hundred acres of Land leaving the overplus thereof in a Regular piece and make exact Returns into the Secretarys Office in order for a further Confirmation Given under our hands and seal of ye Province at Philadelphia the 10th day of the 3^d Month.
