



Beginning at a black oak standing in Gorge Pachmans Line along the same South one hundred and sixteen perches to a hickry then west one hundred and fifty eight perches by vacand Land to a small hickry then north one hundred and two perches to a post by vacand Land then east eighty eight perches to two small black oaks by Crestan Newcumbs Land then north eighteen perches to a post then east by the said Land seventy perches to the place of beginning containing one hundred acres with usual allowance for Roads Surveyed to Jacob Souder on the 17 day of the— month in the year 1733 in the County of Bucks beyond the Great Swamp upon the head branches of Sothcunk
