These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will & Require Thee forthwith to survey unto ye said Robt Turner as purchaser of ye Right of John Gee and Comp<sup>ys</sup> one thousand acres of Land in ye County of ~~the~~ Philadelphia in lieu of ye one thousand formerly laid out in ye County of Bucks as afore said and make Returne thereof into ye Secretarys Office dat at Philadelphia the 14<sup>th</sup> mo 1690.


